Opening of Playground Equipment and Public Washrooms

The Village of Valemount took a proactive approach by closing and keeping closed certain park facilities in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Now that the curve has been flattened, and the Province has initiated the BC Restart Plan, the Village of Valemount will be opening the following facilities on Monday June 15, 2020:

- All Village Playground Equipment
- Centennial Park Public Washrooms
- Centennial Park Tennis Court
- Valemount Skate Park

In order to keep these facilities open, the public is asked to adhere to the guidelines posted at each facility, which are based on the BC Public Health Officer's recommendations:

- Wash or sanitize hands before and after using.
- Maintain physical distance from other users of 6 feet (2 meters).
- Recognize that surfaces may not be sanitized regularly and may be contaminated with COVID-19.
