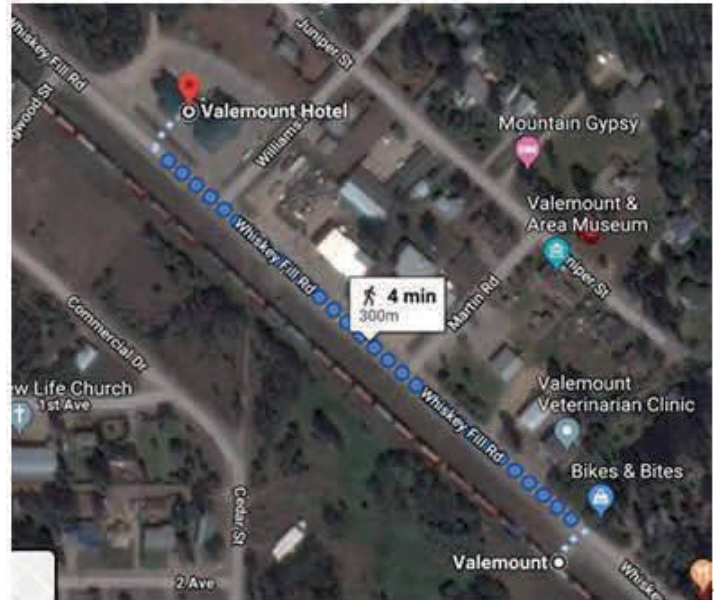

Starting **November 1, 2019**, passengers departing from the Valemount VIA Rail stop and who hold a valid ticket will have access to the Valemount hotel waiting room and pub should they wish to wait for their train indoors. Please note that it remains the passenger's responsibility to monitor train schedules and changes, and be present at the VIA Rail stop prior to the departure of the train.
