Business Licence and Regulation Bylaw Updates

On January 14, 2020, the Business Licence and Regulation Bylaw No 805, 2019 was adopted.

Some notable changes and clarifications from the previous Bylaw include:

- Businesses carrying on from more than one premise in the Village will be deemed a separate business and will each require a business license.
- If two or more persons are each carrying on separate businesses from the same premises, each person requires a separate business license.
- Businesses with commercial kitchens will need to provide proof that the cleaning of the fats, oils and grease interceptor has taken place at least once within the past calendar year prior to the issuance or renewal of a business license. (A grace period has been granted for the issuance of 2020 business licenses.)
- Village residents selling home-made wares at a craft fair hosted by the Village of Valemount, the Chamber of Commerce, or a local non-profit organization are *not required* to have a business license. Exemptions also include yard or garage sales.

- Water rates have increased 5%
- Sewer rates have increased 5%
- Solid Waste collection rates have increased by 3%

- 2020 Utilities are due by December 31, 2020.
- No interest will incur on unpaid amounts until January 1, 2021.
