- ◆ Manage fruit trees so that fruit is picked as it ripens and no windfall accumulates.
- ◆ Keep BBQs clean and odour free.

Please **DO NOT** put your garbage out before the morning of garbage collection. Garbage receptacles left out prior to garbage collection day may be subject to bylaw enforcement measures.

Remove Items From Village Easements

The Village utilizes the easements and boulevards within all residential areas for snow clearing operations throughout the winter. Storing vehicles of any kind (including RV's, boats, utility trailers etc.) or materials such as dirt, gravel, firewood, etc. within Village easements and boulevards is in contravention of Village Bylaws. Violations may result in fines or vehicles being towed at the owners expense should they hinder snow removal efforts. Open Air Burning Bylaw No. 703, 2016

No open burning is allowed within 100 meters of any residence at all times and within 500 meters of any medical centre at all times. This bylaw does not apply to the normal use of charcoal, gas fired or electric grills and barbecues for the purpose of cooking food or approved gas fueled fireplaces or heaters.
