

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: LIFT STATION IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Decommissioning of existing lift stations & installation of new sanitary lift stations.

PROJECT DATES

Construction will commence at the end of June, and conclude at the end of October, 2023. Temporary road closures will be necessary to complete the work.

Garbage Bins

To maintain a sanitary and beautiful environment and for the health and safety of our citizens and Publics Works personnel, here are some tips for residents leaving their garbage for removal:



- Your garbage must be bagged and placed in the Village-supplied collection container. Garbage left curbside out of the collection container will not be removed. Garbage in dumpsters must also be bagged.
- The lid on the collection container must be fully closed so that the ravens cannot gain access. Ravens are smart enough to use even the smallest amount of a garbage bag as a lever to open the can. The resident responsible for the collection container could be fined for littering if garbage “somehow escapes” from the collection container.
- Put your collection container in full view and within 1 metre of the curb by 7:00am in the morning of collection day and bring it in by the end of the day. If you do not know your particular collection day, check with the Village Office at (250) 566-4435.
- Should the Public Works Superintendent deem a property unfit for Collection Service, the Owner or Occupier will be required to work with the Village to develop an alternative arrangement for Collection Service.

Permissive Tax Exemptions

Section 224 of the Community Charter, gives Council the authority to exempt certain land and/or improvements from municipal property taxes. Council considers Permissive Tax Exemptions for non-profit organizations that contribute to the well being of Village residents, make improvements to the quality of life for residents, and/or are an extension of Village Services.

A new application must be completed each year and must be accompanied by all required documentation. The deadline for applications to be received by the Village Office is August 1, 2023.

To be eligible for a Permissive Tax Exemption, an organization must comply with the guidelines and be approved by Council.
