The Village of Valemount is seeking applications for a full-time:

Public Works Labourer/Operator

About the role: Reporting to the Public Works Superintendent this position provides general labour, heavy equipment operation, water treatment plant and or wastewater plant operations for the Village of Valemount.

General Duties include but are not limited to:

- Perform manual labour including, but not limited to pick and shovel work, brush clearing, moving materials, concrete work, jack hammering, etc.
- Assist other employees with their duties including, but not limited to, grounds maintenance, gardening, water and sewer line digging and pipe laying, pavement laying and repair, drainage ditch maintenance, road marking, raking and shoveling.
- Operate power tools and equipment including, but not limited to, tamper, sole plate packer, lawn
 mower, weed eater, snow blower, cement mixer, tar bucket, steam cleaner, jackhammer, sander,
 circular saws, drills, as well as chainsaws and hand tools.
- Assist with assembly, removal and adjustment of attachments to various pieces of equipment.
- Hydrant flushing and yearly maintenance.
- Collect garbage and other debris as necessary from Village Parks, streets, downtown area, Village
 Office and all other areas as deemed necessary by the Superintendent of Public Works.
- Drive light duty vehicles (pickup truck) as required.
- Perform sign maintenance and road marking, repair pavement defects, build minor infrastructure such as catch basins and manholes, etc.
- Flagging duties, as required.
- Emergency call outs and shift work may be required.
- Operating the municipal garbage truck and collecting residential and commercial refuse as required.
- Recording Water and Waste Water Meter Readings.
- Assisting with change out of meters, pumps, controls, and chlorine bottles.
- Inspect equipment daily for visible damage, for fluid and fuel requirements. Electrical systems, tire checks, etc., and report any defects to the Public Works Superintendent.
- Other duties as required.

Heavy Equipment Operation

As required by supervisor:

- Backhoe in relation to municipal service installations and repair.
- Grader in relation to establishing road grades.
- Solid Waste Disposal Truck.
- Wastewater Truck.
- Snow Removal Equipment.
- Street Sweeper.

Core Courses

The following are required courses for employment. Training will be made available for the right candidate:

- Completion of Grade 12.
- Valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's License with Air endorsement.
- Occupational First Aid Level I.
- W.H.M.I.S.
- Confined Space & Entry Rescue.
- Ground Disturbance Level II.
- Flagging.

Wage and Benefits:

The starting wage for this position is \$23.18/hour. Relevant experience will be considered during the hiring process and may influence this value. Testing may be conducted as part of the recruitment process.
